



Vaccinations

A vaccination, or immunization, is medicine's way of helping an animal to protect itself against disease. Because puppies and kittens do not have a way to fight off disease on their own, your veterinarian must help to protect them with vaccinations.

Rainbow City Pet Clinic recommends a series of 3 sets of vaccinations beginning at age 6-8 weeks for all puppies and kittens and then **annually thereafter**.

Puppies:

6 – 8 weeks of age	DHPP = distemper, hepatitis, parainfluenza and parvo virus
9 – 12 weeks of age	DHPP-C = distemper, hepatitis, parainfluenza, parvo and corona virus
13 – 16 weeks of age	DHPP-C and Rabies

Kittens:

6– 8 weeks of age	FVR-CP = feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and panleukopenia or feline distemper
9 – 12 weeks of age	FVR-CP and Leukemia 1
13 – 16 weeks of age	FVR-CP, Leukemia 2 and Rabies

Bordetella (Kennel cough) may be given at 8 weeks of age in puppies or kittens and then annually
